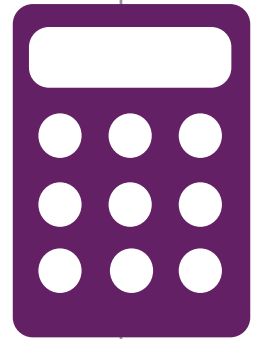
How New Awards Impact Your Financial Aid

New Scholarships, Grants, Private Loans

If your aid already covers your cost of attendance referenced above, other loans and sometimes grants will be reduced as a result of new awards.

What can I do?

If you receive grants, scholarships, fellowships, or other financial aid that is meant to cover educational expenses such as travel, research supplies, equipment for a learning disability, etc the Office of Financial Aid can increase your cost of attendance budget which will prevent the loss of other aid.
